Orange County has many unique natural habitats from oak woodlands in the mountains, coastal sage scrub in the valleys, and coastal dunes on the beaches. OC Habitats™, a 501(3)c nonprofit organization (EIN: 82-2478090), was founded in 2017 to help conserve and protect these natural habitats. Our organization supports our habitats through educational programs, wildlife and habitat monitoring, outreach, and restoration events. In 2019, we provided programs for over 700 students and adults and worked on three habitat restoration projects within the OC Parks system. Our habitat monitoring has expanded to include every accessible beach in Orange County and are data are being shared and used by agencies like California State Parks, Coastal Commission, California Department of Fish and Wildlife, and US Fish and Wildlife service to help with conservation of our listed species. 2020 brought many challenges to the world and at OCH we are accepting this as a challenge to grow and flow with these changes.
