



Where your Donation Goes with OCH

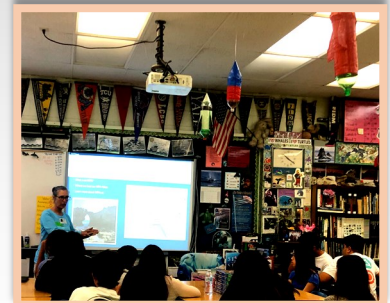
Orange County has many unique natural habitats from oak woodlands in the mountains, coastal sage scrub in the valleys, and coastal dunes on the beaches. OC Habitats™, a 501(3)c nonprofit organization (EIN: 82-2478090), was founded in 2017 to help conserve and protect these natural habitats. Our organization supports our habitats through educational and outreach programs, wildlife and habitat monitoring, and restoration events. Since our inception, we have provided programs for over 5000 students and individuals through our school and public outreach programs. Our habitat monitoring programs have expanded to monitoring intertidal habitats for sea urchins, inland bird species in our local canyons and continuing our habitat and shorebird surveys along our coast. We have worked with many partner groups on our restoration projects in Orange, Santa Ana, Irvine, Newport and Huntington beaches helping to restore local coastal sage, riparian, and wetland habitats. Some of our projects and programs are paid but many are not and we fundraise through grants, donations and fundraising events to cover the costs of our work efforts in all areas of our organization.

A **\$50-100** donation supports our education programs with:

- Educational materials used for our programs that we provide at local Title 1 Schools (paper, ink, display boards, markers)
- Monitoring and restoration supplies like field guides, first aid kits, backpacks, and gloves for our survey monitors and restoration staff/volunteers.
- Support the reimbursement of gas expenses to our college interns from local colleges.



A **\$101-1000** donation can:

- Helps to support one restoration projects in either Upper Newport Bay, Irvine, and Santa Ana (all unpaid programs) to cover supplies and administrative costs.
- Print educational materials such as 100 coloring books, our species specific stickers
- Help cover the cost of a school site program for Title 1 school group
- Help cover the cost of a off-site field trip for Title 1 school group



A **\$1001-5000** donation can:

- Cover the cost of an off-site field trip program for 40 students with one bus
- Help to support our restoration efforts in underserved communities such as Santa Ana.
